Ration Distribution

Our organization distribute every year Ration in our area distribute ration kit programs provide essential groceries to individuals and families in need, often during times of crisis or hardship. Through our Food Kit Distribution program, we aim to alleviate food insecurity by providing essential food supplies to those in need. With strategic partnerships and community outreach, we ensure that individuals and families have access to nutritious meals, promoting health and dignity for all. To tackle this crisis, our Monthly Ration Kit Campaign distributes 100 dry ration kits every month, ensuring that families receive the food they need to survive. Food Distribution

Our organization distribute every year food to During this period of lockdown the informal worker who basically manages meeting family's survival needs by earning through daily wage work, are facing severe crisis. MANOBIK RANAGHAT plans to provide dry ration kits to 10000 such workers' families in the coverage area to meet their immediate food needs.

Winter Clothes Distribution

MANOBIK RANAGHAT, a city-based NGO, distributed blankets and woolens among poor and shelter less persons and needy at the Railway Station road, and different parts of the city, here on Sunday.

“With the night temperature dipping low and dense fog engulfing the city, the homeless and the destitute on the streets and roadside have just plastic sheets to save themselves from cold. The blanket donation is just to help the poor in distress”, said Mr. Subash Nath, an entrepreneur and founder member of the NGO. “Cold waves have already claimed many lives in the past days and are affecting many sleeping out on the streets and footpaths, such as rickshaw-pullers and beggars. We are urging people to come forward to donate warm clothes, bed sheets and quilts,” she added. Winter clothes distribution programs are crucial for providing warmth and protection to vulnerable populations during the colder months. These initiatives, often organized by NGOs and community groups, involve collecting and distributing items like blankets, sweaters, and other warm clothing to those in need, such as the homeless, impoverished families, and marginalized communities. Such programs not only address immediate needs but also contribute to the overall well-being and resilience of individuals facing harsh winter conditions.

Grocery Distribution

MANOBIK RANAGHAT, a city-based NGO, distributed Grocery material in the process of moving food products from producers to consumers, involving various players and steps like transportation, storage, and delivery to grocery stores. It's a crucial part of the food supply

chain, ensuring products reach stores on time and in good condition. Grocery distribution is complex with many players that produce, manufacture, transport, distribute, market, and sell every type of food product imaginable. By the time a product is placed on a grocery store shelf, it has traveled countless miles and has been handled by many people. Making sure the right product gets to right store at peak freshness required technology along the whole supply chain. Data logic technology delivers solutions for automated and manual data collection for grocery distribution. Distribution is an essential part of the food supply chain in the India.
